### Guam's cargo operator Asia Pacific starts fleet renewal with B757

Asia Pacific Airlines (Guam) (P9, [Guam Int'l](#)) is planning to introduce a first [B757-200\(F\)](#) freighter to its fleet by April or May of this year, a Tan Holdings spokesperson has confirmed to ch-aviation.

The ex-[Nordwind Airlines](#) (N4, [Moscow Sheremetyevo](#)) aircraft N757QM (msn 27203) will be converted by Precision Aircraft Solutions and initially operate on routes between Guam and [Honolulu](#).

Asia Pacific currently operates three [B727-200\(F\)](#) freighters operating from Guam via [Majuro](#) to Honolulu, from Guam to [Pohnpei](#) and between Honolulu and [Pago Pago](#).

The carrier is also considering offering services to the US West Coast in the long run.
