JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan material requirements and coordinate material flow through the supply chain to support aircraft build schedules, and kitting requirements.
- Participate in the supplier selection process and negotiations to achieve the best possible terms and conditions for the company.
- Support shop supplies, tools, assembly aids, and hardware needed to support continuous production through the manufacturing and assembly shops.
- Lead the RFQ process to initiate supplier contact, evaluate supplier quotes, and make recommendations regarding purchase quantity, pricing, and technical ability to meet company objectives.
- Maintain positive supplier relations and manage supplier performance including quality, delivery, and continuous improvement activities. May require some travel for performance reviews/audits.
- Manage change requests through proactive communications with suppliers and prioritize work flow to meet critical requirements. Work to understand and resolve root cause for changes to minimize schedule volatility.
- Negotiate and manage pricing and quality discrepancies along with returned material processes as necessary.
- Participate in the development of the company's supply chain strategies and continuous improvement efforts.
- Work creatively with other functions including quality, engineering, finance, customer support, and logistics as required to solve problems and assure supply chain processes are optimized.
- Key performance objectives include timely placement of purchase orders, on time delivery, supplier quality, inventory, material cost, and personal growth plan.
