

## **MRO Quality Assurance Auditor**

We are seeking an MRO Quality Assurance Auditor to work at our partner MROs in the United States and in China. This full-time position reports to the Quality Manager and is based in Sanford, FL.

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Provide quality oversight of company processes, policies, and procedures through the use of onsite monitoring and audits of MRO maintenance, repair and alteration activity.
- Conduct assessments through analysis and interpretation of objective evidence to ensure compliance with established company quality standards and contractual requirements.
- Monitor MRO compliance with regulatory requirements, company engineering drawings, task cards, process specifications and quality standards.
- Inspect aircraft installations for fastener installation, cable harness assembly installation, equipment installation, fastener installation, sealing, etc. for acceptable workmanship, proper functioning, and completeness.
- Ensure non-conformities are properly dispositioned in accordance with company procedures and standards.
- Define and maintain an effective and efficient quality MRO audit program.
- Independently and objectively plan and execute MRO quality system, process, and performance audits in accordance with professional auditing standards.
- Prepare audit reports which include formal recommendations to the MRO for review and implementation.
- Enter findings into a computerized quality reporting database, review corrective actions, and assist with implementation of recommendations.
- Champion problem solving and root cause analysis activities with partner MROs to eliminate recurrence of non-conformances.
- Follow up with MROs to ensure corrective actions are implemented in a timely manner.
- Verify implementation and effectiveness of corrective actions through continuous observation and follow up audits.
- Collect, analyze, and report MRO performance quality metrics across all MROs to identify process-level failures and breakdowns.
- Serve as company point-of-contact for MRO quality related issues.
- Maintain a working knowledge of regulatory requirements and industry quality assurance codes and standards.
- Monitor and report to the Quality Assurance Manager quality-related metrics, including but not limited to, MRO quality escapes to meet established organizational goals.
- Other tasks reasonably requested due to the nature of the position.



## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's degree in a related technical field; relevant experience will be considered in lieu of degree
- FAA Airframe and Powerplant (A&P) license required
- Minimum 3 years' aircraft quality inspection experience, preferably in an MRO facility
- Minimum 3 years' aircraft sheet metal repair and/or alteration experience
- Minimum 3 years' audit experience in a FAR 145 or FAR 121/135 quality environment
- Experience reading and interpreting engineering drawings, specifications and instructions
- Demonstrated analytical skills to proactively identify and solve problems
- Proficient in use of Microsoft Office applications
- Extensive domestic and international travel required
